4. A minimum of **10 graded credit hours** counting toward the minor must be completed at Eastern Oregon University.
5. Should this minor be combined with another English/Writing minor as part of a Liberal Studies degree, no more than one course should overlap with the other minor.
6. Please note that pre-requisites may not be taken as co-requisites.
