The main purpose of the ESOL concentration is to prepare future teachers with the ESOL skills needed to successfully instruct English Learners from all over the world. It is a useful for those who wish to teach English in linguistically diverse schools in the United States, and for those who wish to teach English as a foreign language in another country. In addition, this concentration provides opportunities for students in a variety of programs to learn more about diversity in the United States in the meaningful context of language studies.

A minimum of 15 program credits must be completed at EOU. All transfer courses must be transcripted and syllabi must be evaluated for approval by the ESOL team leader. ESOL program practica (90hours) must be completed at EOU, which includes ED 421L, and ED 479.
