At least 10 graded credit hours counting toward the minor must be completed at Eastern Oregon University.

If this minor is declared with the Interdisciplinary Writing & Rhetoric minor, only one course can overlap with the other minor.

- Interdisciplinary Studies Students are then encourages to enroll in the English Capstone sequence: WR 402 Capstone I (1) in Fall and WR 403 Capstone II in Winter, or they may enroll in LS 401.
