UNIVERSITY SCHOLAR AWARD

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

University Scholar Awards are offered to incoming freshmen based on their high school GPA, Standardized test scores; SAT (math & reading) or ACT (composite score), and the timing of their admittance to EOU. <u>Early consideration is given to students admitted by November 1st</u> and <u>priority awarding is given to students admitted by February 1st</u>, who will attend the following fall term. There is no application process specifically for this award. Students will be automatically offered this award based on their eligibility criteria and the date of admission into EOU.

RENEWAL CRITERIA:

This award is renewable for up to 12 terms (4-year equivalency). To maintain eligibility for this award, students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA and earn 45-credit hours at EOU, per regular academic year (fall, winter, and spring terms). The Financial Aid Office will monitor your academic progress and determine your eligibility to renew.

The University Scholar Award cannot be awarded simultaneously with the Transfer & Continuing Student Success Award, or the University Achievement, as these are partner programs. If a student is receiving other Institutional Aid Awards, their total Institutional Aid cannot exceed the cost of their total tuition and fees. *Consortium or dual-enrolled students will only receive credit toward their award for the credits they are taking at Eastern Oregon University.

REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE FUNDS:

Awards are based on full-time enrollment and will not pay if you are registered for less than full-time (12 credit hours per term). Study abroad programs do not count as credits registered with EOU.

One-third of your award funds will be released directly into your student account each term and will apply to tuition and fees.
