RETURN FORM TO FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

When a student fails to earn a passing grade in any class, EOU must have a procedure for determining whether a federal aid recipient, who began attendance during a term, completed the term or whether the student should be treated as a withdrawal.

Until we can document that you attended at least one class, we will consider you to have unofficially withdrawn. You *will be billed* for any amount of aid returned to Federal accounts after the deadline below.

You can avoid being unofficially withdrawn by obtaining verification of your last date of academically related activity from *at least* one of your instructors. Follow these steps:

- 1. Complete the student section of this form and take it or e-mail it to your professor.
- 2. Politely ask your professor to provide and verify the "last *date* of academically related activity" you had in the class. Do not ask the professor to certify that you completed any percentage of the class. You only need to have the last *date* of academically related activity.
 - If you are unable to get a response from faculty, please contact the respective Dean's Office for each course. The Dean's Office can complete this form in faculty's absence.
- 3. <u>Return the form to the Financial Aid Office by mail, email, or fax</u>. It is *your* responsibility to make sure that the form is received by our office by the deadline. Realize that many professors do not have office hours during breaks, and plan accordingly.

L am a consortium student: If you received grades at your host school, you must send in this form with a copy of your final grade report from the host school. The grade report *must also show* your name *and* the term. If you failed to earn any passing grades, document your last *date* of academically related activity as provided in the above instructions.
